Mathematics:

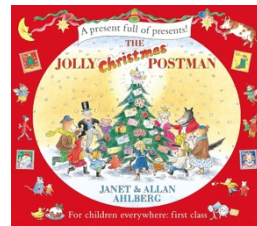
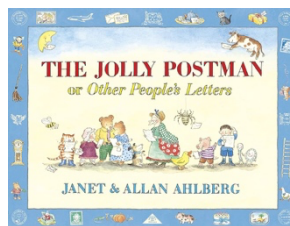
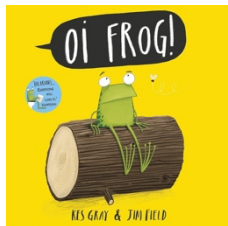
As mathematicians we continue to explore numbers within 20, addition and subtraction within 10, name simple 2D and 3D shapes and create simple repeated patterns.

Please encourage your child to look for numbers in the environment and raise the profile of mathematical problems.



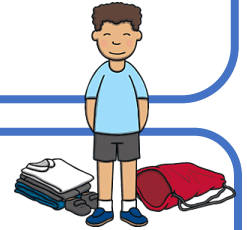
English:
